Department of Foreign Languages and Literature Recommendations on Publications for Faculty Promotions

Amended and approved by the 10th Department of Foreign Languages and Literature Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting on May 19, 2004, School Year 92.

Amended and approved by the 5th Department of Foreign Languages and Literature Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting on March 1, 2005, School Year 93.

Amended and approved by the 1st Department of Foreign Languages and Literature General Meeting on March 15, 2005, 2nd Semester of School Year 93.

Amended by the 2nd Department of Foreign Languages and Literature Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting on October 4, 2012, School Year 101.

When applying for a promotion, a faculty member of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literature may submit publications written in English in any of the following three styles:

- I. An academic book: No less than 50,000 words or containing 4 major chapters (not including introduction and conclusion); printed by a publisher.
- II. At least three independent articles published in journals or book chapters, each with no less than 6,000 words.
- III. One doctoral dissertation: Only applicable to a faculty member who was previously promoted through the old promotion system or who has not submitted the doctoral dissertation for any reviews previously.

When submitting applications, the publications mentioned above must be openly published or published by renowned domestic or international journals within five years. Publications mentioned in I and II must not be degree theses, chapters of degree theses, or their rewritten versions.
